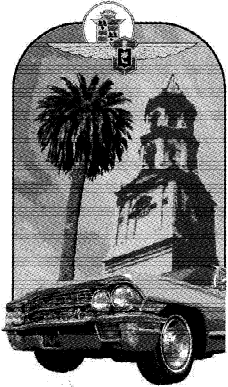

* Modified vehicles must meet CLC vehicle requirements; i.e., must be recognizable as a Cadillac or LaSalle product, and be powered by an engine used by Cadillac or LaSalle.

† If you check Display Only, your vehicle will not be conventional judged—last-minute transfer to conventional judging not allowed, but it may be judged as a preservation vehicle if eligible.

§ Vehicles registered as modified and vehicles model year 2000 and newer will not be judged in conventional judging. They are display only.

Preservation Vehicle—Judged is for vehicles 30 years or older and almost all original (not restored to "original"). To be judged, write an "X" in the Preservation Vehicle Judged column, and fill out and enclose a Preservation Application Form (see page 66 of the CLC 2012 International Membership Directory). Preservation vehicles may also be judged in appropriate conventional classes (include Class number on Vehicle Registration Form); if not, it must be entered in Display Only. No additional entry fee.

** Class, see CLC 2012 International Membership Directory, pp. 61–62. Write T (Touring), P (Primary), S (Senior), SW (Senior Wreath) or SC (Senior Crown) plus class number in the Class Number column above. If vehicle is modified Division, write M in Display Only column. If vehicle is entered in Preservation Class, refer to footnote immediately above this one.

Attention Senior vehicle entrants: Check your vehicle's Senior Badge number in the CLC 2012 Directory (pp. 67–77). If it has won a first place in the Senior Division, there will be a "W" after its number, so enter it in the Senior Wreath Division where it will be judged. If it has won a first in the Wreath Division, there will be a "WC" after its number, so enter it in the Senior Crown Division. Please enter your vehicle in the appropriate Division and Class.

IMPORTANT:

Members are required to carry liability and property damage insurance on any vehicle entered in the 2012 Grand National Meet. Show participants must be current National members of the Cadillac & LaSalle Club, Inc. All show participants must register for the meet to enter a vehicle for display or to be judged. Vehicles entered in the CLC judging event must be owned by a member of the Cadillac & LaSalle Club, Inc. I, the undersigned, am aware that my vehicle(s) must be insured and that I cannot hold the Cadillac & LaSalle Club, Inc., or the Florida Suncoast Region, responsible for any accidents, property damage or loss while attending or participating in this Club activity.

For all events and tours, you must be preregistered and you must have the appropriate tour ticket to gain admission.

Our Host Hotel

The Renaissance Resort at World Golf Village is a AAA Four-Diamond venue! The resort offers well-appointed accommodations, featuring 37-inch flat-panel TVs, high-speed wireless Internet access, wet bars, refrigerators and other luxuries. Within 15 minutes of the resort, enjoy 108 holes of championship golf, including the Slammer and Squire, located steps from your guest room. The hotel has golf packages and fishing packages; beach access available at your request. The Florida Suncoast Region contracted for rooms at \$89 per night. Don't miss Our Nation's First City Grand National!

Our Tours and Events

Castillo de San Marcos Fort—The Castillo was built to defend Spain's claims in the New World. A monument of stone, mortar and human determination, the Castillo offers a diverse range of programs, including ranger talks, historical weapons demonstrations and living history reenactments. **The Lightner Museum** features relics of America's Gilded Age. Costumes and artifacts give you a glimpse into a past era. The Lightner collection includes the stained glass work of Louis Comfort Tiffany. *Tour includes transportation to and from hotel and admissions to the Fort and Lightner Museum. Lunch is not included. Wear comfortable shoes—a moderate amount of walking is required.*

Alligator Farm Zoological Park—Founded in 1893, it is one of Florida's oldest zoological attractions. It has entertained millions of visitors, lured by the awesome presence of these mysterious reptiles.

St. Augustine Lighthouse & Museum—Climb to the top of this St. Augustine icon, built in 1874, and see the city from a fascinating view. You can now enjoy touring the lighthouse and lightkeeper's house, visiting the museum store and relaxing on the beautiful grounds. *Tour includes transportation to the Lighthouse Museum and Alligator Farm, admission fees and return to hotel. Lunch is not included. If you are unable to walk up or down steep stairs at the*

lighthouse, there are plenty of interesting activities on the ground.

Daytona International Speedway—

Discover what makes Daytona International Speedway the world center of racing. On the approximately 90-minute all-access tour, explore the drivers' meeting room, NASCAR Sprint Cup Series garages, Gatorade Victory Lane, and go inside the Houston Lawing Press Box seven stories above the Speedway. Daytona is approximately two hours from St. Augustine. *For the tour on Thursday, choose from tour and lunch option or add on an opportunity to drive your car on the track. The host Region will coordinate transportation to and from the track if you are not planning on driving your car. Advise if you are willing to take extra passengers in your car. The tour on Friday is only a ridealong with a driver in a race car and lunch. Track drive requires a minimum of 50 cars. In the event 50 cars do not sign up, members will be transported by motorcoach at additional charge.*

The Fountain of Youth and dinner at the famous Columbia Restaurant

—The Timucua Indian Village of Seloy existed here for almost 4,000 years before the arrival of the Spanish in 1513, and with Ponce de Leon's claim of possession for the Spanish King in 1513, "La Florida" was born. Our exploration begins with a drink from the legendary Fountain of Youth. Explore a 15-acre waterfront park with a museum and recreated Indian village. After this, our motorcoach takes us to the **Columbia Restaurant**, featuring marvelous Spanish cuisine. This century-old establishment first opened in Tampa by Casimiro Hernandez Sr. The award-winning cuisine is set in a distinctly Spanish atmosphere. *Tour includes transportation, the Fountain of Youth and dinner.*

Proposed Youth Activities—To be determined, based on ages of youth and participation.

World Golf Hall of Fame IMAX Theater—Located right on the grounds of our host hotel, the theater features the Southeast's largest IMAX 3D digital screen! IMAX theaters are specifically designed to deliver the world's most

immersive movie experience. Now the 299-seat World Golf Hall of Fame IMAX Theater includes totally new 3D system and equipment.

Visit Ripley's first and oldest Believe It or Not! Odditorium, with unusual art and unbelievable artifacts, from around the globe! The museum features "weird class" family fun. Collections include real shrunken human heads and the Peel Car, the world's smallest production car. Marvel at the largest operational erector set Ferris wheel and even take your picture with The Lizard Man! Over 800 other unique exhibits await you! This tour will be enjoyed by kids of all ages.

The St. Augustine Pirate & Treasure Museum—

Discover a collection of authentic pirate artifacts, coupled with elements of interactive technology revealing historic adventures from the Golden Age of Piracy. Among more than 800 museum-quality artifacts, threaded through the storyline is the original journal of Captain Kidd's last voyage, the only authentic pirate treasure chest in the world that originally belonged to Captain Thomas Tew, and the oldest pirate wanted poster for the capture of Captain Henry Every.

Bayfront Mini Golf is located next to the Bridge of Lions in the heart of historic St. Augustine. Bayfront Mini Golf originally opened in 1949, making it the oldest miniature golf course in the oldest city!

Saturday Tour

Take a break from the car activities, hop on the shuttle from the hotel to historic St. Augustine and transport yourself to an eclectic selection of antique shops, art galleries and boutiques, just one minute from World Golf Village. From the shops of St. George Street to the Antique Row on San Marco Boulevard, you will enjoy the shopping options.

Check the concierge desk for the hotel shuttle to Old St. Augustine, which drops off and picks up at the Trolley Stop. It's your agenda for the afternoon. Enjoy a city tour on the trolley or lunch and some shopping. Need assistance? There are cabs to bring you back to the hotel. Don't forget the outlet malls a short drive away. ■
